An awards program will be provided after the tournament with prizes for the heaviest sack of bass, 2<sup>nd</sup> heaviest sack bass and 3<sup>rd</sup> heaviest sack of bass, the heaviest bass, and the smallest bass. All Local, State, and Federal regulations are to be followed.

Registration must accompany your state annual meeting registration with checks made payable to the District 5 TCAAA. (This may be included with your state registration check or, a separate check can be attached for those whose county pays your annual meeting registration fee).

You will receive a confirmation and map to the tournament site at Cassels-Boykin boat ramp after your registration fees are received.

#### **Tournament Rules**

- 1. Tournament begins at 2:00pm
- 2. Each player will receive \$100 in chips with their entry fee.
- 3. Players will be divided equally at playing tables. Players will draw for seat number and table number before tournament starts.
- 4. Players are responsible for dealing at their table. The deal will move clockwise around table.
- 5. Any over-turned card must be shown to all players at table.
- 6. Miss-deal can be called by any player at the table if a card is exposed or the hand is dealt improperly.
- 7. Cards speak for themselves regardless of the hand called by the player.
- 8. Blinds will start at \$5.00/\$10.00 and double every fifteen minutes.
- 9. One winner from each table will advance to the final table. The final tables' players will be issued playing money. Final table blinds will start at \$25.00/\$50.00 and double every fifteen minutes. If game is running late we reserve the right to increase blinds as needed.
- 10. Payout will be 50%-30% -20% of the purse.
