This three part tour will begin at the Real Hog Farm, an operation that raises commercial and show hogs, cattle, and agricultural crops. Next, tour the Producers Co-op Feed Mill in Seguin which grinds and mixes feeds for a variety of show and general livestock. The final stop will be at the Texas Agricultural Education and Heritage Center, more fondly known as The Big Red Barn. View old agricultural machinery, the Pecan Museum of Texas, and other agricultural exhibits.
