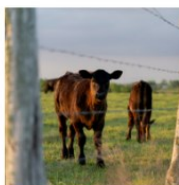

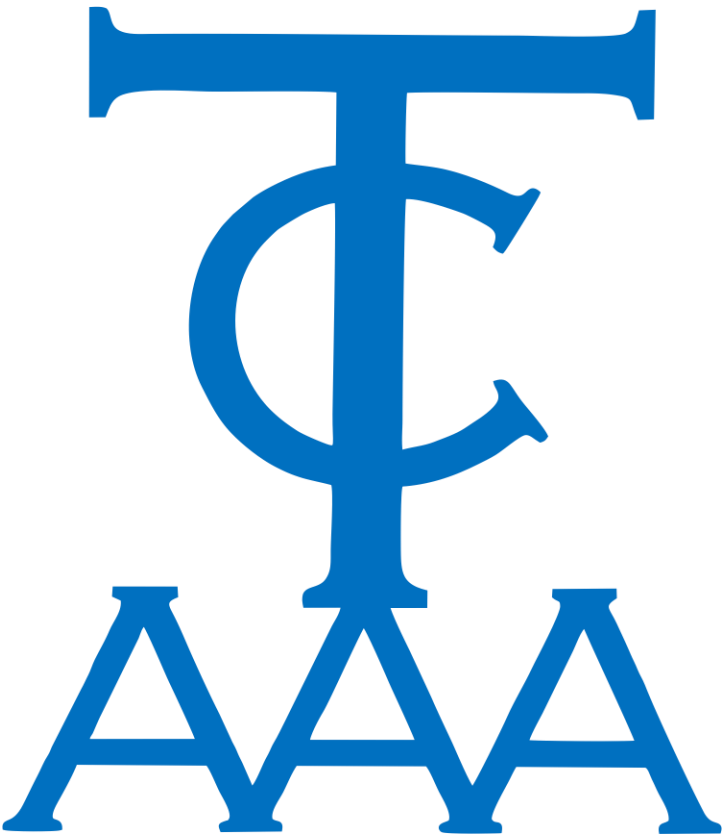

PRIZE MONEY & SCHOLARSHIPS

TEXAS COUNTY AGRICULTURAL AGENTS ASSOCIATION

HUTCHINSON RAFFLE TICKETS

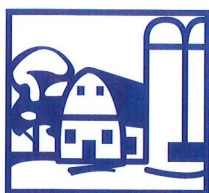
